

#### **ARTISTS + PERFORMERS**



**Aaron Nigel Smith** is a Grammy-nominated producer and Billboard #1 artist who has performed at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center, Lollapalooza, and Pickathon. He is also an educator who has worked with Young Audiences, The Right Brain Initiative, and Arts for Learning.



a.c.ramírez de arellaño (Taino) is a celebrated speaker and multimedia artist who utilizes public spaces to create dialogue that educates, inspires, and builds bridges between communities. A.C. will be presenting an interactive art installation, *Ayotola'ki'ho—Interwoven*.



**DJ ALoSo** is a NYC born, PDX based, queer-latino DJ, artist, and collaborative community visionary. His musical influences come from underground realms within grunge, street art and the eclectic diverse sounds of various cultural rhythms.



**Alta Vocez** is a Hip Hop Duo (sometimes solo) that is proving why street music is universal no matter what language. Effortlessly mixing Spanish and English lyrics with beats that call out to their Latinx heritage Alta Vocez is claiming the stage as their own and blazing a path forward.



Anis Mojgani is the current Poet Laureate of Oregon and is a two-time individual champion of the National Poetry Slam and winner of the International World Cup Poetry Slam. His work has appeared on HBO, NPR, and the Academy of American Poets Poem-A-Day series.

**DJ** Anjali has existed as the city's primary advocate and dance missionary for the many varied electronic sounds of the South Asian/desi diaspora since 2000. She introduced "bhangra" & "Bollywood" to the dance floors of Portland.



The Beautiful Street is a freestyle dance battle where local street and club dancers employ breakdancing, hip-hop, house, locking, popping, voguing, and waacking to determine who's boss.



BodyVox's Junior Artist Generation (JAG) is a dance training program by this internationally renowned, Portland-based dance group. Designed for high school and gap-year dancers, BodyVox seeks to infuse students with a commitment to performance, curiosity and joy in life, art, and, dance.



Bow & Arrow Culture Club and Pi Nee Waus will be presenting Native crafts and games and setting up space for our local Indigenous elders within the Daa-nu'-yash space.



**Chainsaw Girl** is an anti-capitalist band from the stolen land called Portland, Oregon. Chainsaw is an accomplice with the masses that oppose Fascism across the globe.



**Chibia**, a singer/songwriter, is changing the color of traditional R&B with sultry soundscapes that thoughtfully pair deep, meditative vibes, introspective musings, inventive melodies, and lush productions to realize her uniquely soulful sound.



**Cinnamon Kills First** is a published author, documentary filmmaker, and traditional bead worker. As a word warrior, she is dedicated to facing hard truths to bring about change. Cinnamon will be presenting *Onlya Wičo'zani: Breathing Life into Our Ancestors Prophecies*.



Collection of Lone Souljahs is an exciting high energy island style reggae band from Vancouver, WA with roots in Maui, HI. This group of "lone soldiers" has come together to form a band that will surely keep you on your feet. Join our collection and dance with us!



**Dina y los Rumberos** is a family of Cuban musicians who studied in the top music schools Havana. They play Son, Cha Cha Cha, Guaracha, Rumba, Guaguanco, Timba, and Salsa, along with other Caribbean and tropical rhythms such as: Cumbia, Merengue, and Bachata.



**8Flat** will spin eclectic vibes including Hip Hop, R&B, and international music.



**Ed Edmo** (Shoshone-Bannock) is a poet, playwright, performer, traditional storyteller, tour guide, and lecturer on Northwest tribal culture. Ed will be sharing poetry and traditional stories.



**Espacio Flamenco** creates space in Portland, OR for flamenco arts and culture to be experienced and enjoyed through music and dance instruction, professional performance, and special events.

#### **ARTISTS + PERFORMERS**



**4-Directions** is a family drum group founded in 1986 that has performed for many ceremonies across the Pacific Northwest. The group will present a Powwow Hour of dancers, singers, and verse with well-known poet **Alisha Spotted Eagle**.



**Fish Martinez (aka 2 8 Tha Native)** is enrolled in the Confederated Tribes of Siletz and is educator and performing artist who enjoys working with youth and sharing knowledge to encourage and support others.



**Gila Suspectum** is Director of the Portland Two spirit society, a DJ, and an Indigenous adoptee advocate. They are **Akimel O'odham** and **Yaqui** and grew up in Portland and are the co-convener of the "Two Spirits Drag Show."



**Grupo Latitudes** is music from the Andes and Latin Folk from Salvadorian Composer Tito Amaya bringing diversity, happiness, and peace with Latin Folk instruments, history, beat, and singing.



**DJ Mr. Harry** is an absolute monster on the decks. Known for his unhinged and savage style of mixing, wild mashups of modern dance, rave tracks, feral techno beats, and the distorted bass of modern digicore/hyperpop.



**IDEAL PDX** showcases Latino visual and performing arts to strengthen artists' integration into the local economy. For Paseo IDEAL is creating three murals during the festival. Also check out their mural in the Portland Art Museum made for the exhibit *Frida Kahlo*, *Diego Rivera*, and *Mexican Modernism*.



Jai Baby is a Portland based rapper, singer, songwriter, and producer known best for her pop/hip-hop sound as well as high energy stage presence. The 2021 release of her music video and hit single "Bad B" caught the attention of many radio stations across the world.



**JERMAINE** brings a charismatic energy and passion for music, from smooth and sultry R&B crooning to chill Hip Hop flows. His main joy is bringing a smile to your face and a shake to your hips.



**DJ Jim and DJ Karen** have been deejays at Freeform Portland Community Radio for 6 years. They play international funk, soul, boogie, and synth sounds curated on vinyl.



**Kalabharati School of Dance** is a 29-year-old premier Portland school that promotes and presents Bharathanatyam, an ancient South Indian dance form, through instructional classes and professional performances.



**Kunu** is a multimedia producer, storyteller, hip hop artist, filmmaker, and educator. Northern Cheyenne on his father's side and Ho-chunk Nation on his mother's side, he raises the profile of Indigenous people through his creative work.



**LaRhonda Steele Band**, an Oregon Music Hall of Fame inductee, brings to the stage a Soulful, Bluesy fun time with her band. Family and dancer friendly with original and cover songs rounding out their sets. LaRhonda and band guarantees you will have a "Funky Good Time."

#### **ARTISTS + PERFORMERS**



**The Poet Lady Rose** (she/her/they) is a queer Black and Indigenous femme educator, entrepreneur, and poet who performs as Lady Rose. Her first book, *Holes of a Piece of Me: An Introduction to Lady Rose*, is expected to be released in July 2022



Laura Ivancie is a Portland-based singer and songwriter who mixes electronic, alternative, folk, rock, country, jazz, blues, and soul. Most often wrapped around an acoustic guitar, Laura's soulful voice has turned her small-town appeal into a national allure.



**Lukas Soto** focuses on a racial equity, justice, and community to uplift the voices of populations that are most often invisibilized, silenced, and erased. He is co-convener of the "Two Spirits Drag Show" and will be at a booth where you "Can ask the hard questions."



**Machado Mijiga** is a multi-Instrumentalist, composer, audio engineer, and educator whose music spans jazz fusion to the lo-fi hip-hop he produces under the alias **Gohan Blanco**.



Madame Golong (Crystal Martin) is a drummer, songwriter, vocalist, and music producer who fronts the band and record label **Thunder Snatch**. She's toured internationally and played drums with CIARA, B.O.B. CHUCK D (Public Enemy), and many more. She mixes Funk, Soul, Rock, Rap, Hip hop, POP, Electronic, Punk Rock, Gospel, and Reggae.



**DJ Mami Miami**, AKA Chicana writer **Emilly Prado**, dreams of nights spent with hips swaying in international multi-story discotecas. She is one-part of Noche Libre, the Latinx DJ collective she co-founded

in 2017. Her sets encompass genres from Andean cumbias and hip-hop to 1960s oldies, 80's new wave, and Puerto Rican punk rock.



**Mei Anna** is a Portland acoustic singer, guitarist, and songwriter. She is a full-time student at Knox College in Illinois studying Psychology and Music.

**Mexica dance** is an indigenous dance and spiritual practice in the Mexica region of Mexico, including the Aztec and Mayan peoples. It carries stories and knowledge passed down through the generations. Dance, drums, and instruments connect to the earth and cosmos creating energy for a better tomorrow.



**New Birth Crew** is a competitive break dance group, now with members from around the world, that started as a group of friends from Lane Middle School.



**DJ Opal and DJ Ayler** have been deejays at Freeform Portland Community Radio for six years on *Weekend Family Music Hour*. They play a set of eclectic indie, shoegaze, rock, punk, and sonic sounds highlighting BIPOC and women artists

**Portland Jazz Collective** is a local high school ensemble founded in 2021. The group is inspired by Charlie Parker, Miles Davis, and Wynton Kelly.



**Psychotropika** (Chilean / Indigenous Mexican) is an experimental music project, spanning influences from Dub, Downtempo, Hip Hop and Trap always with a Latin flavor, nuanced by traditional rhythms, Indigenous instruments, and Shamanic harmonies, plus immersive video montages.

**Rainezra** is a 22-year-old R&B-influenced singer/songwriter and producer. She has performed at Paris Theater, Jack London, and Al's Den. She has a new project out called *Responsibilities*, now available on all platforms.



**Rejoice!** is a Portland-based contemporary dance ensemble led by **Oluyinka Akinjiola**. Inspired by the folklore of the great African diaspora, Rejoice!'s performance repertoire boldly weaves stories of adversity and hope.



Roots & Beats Project (Chilean and Indigenous Mexican) fosters positive youth development through media arts education and cultural engagement by merging tradition and technology to weave culturally rooted digital storytelling focusing on immigrant, refugee, and ethnic diaspora experience. They will be hosting an interactive booth where children and adults can explore sound, recording, and beat making.



**7 Waters Canoe Family** is a group of urban natives who connect with nature in and around the city, share in the abundance around us, and pull together for active healing and ceremony. The Canoe is the vessel that carries us forward to the future and from which we make our guiding decisions.



**Shaun Keylock Company** is an award-winning choreographer, director, teacher, and dancer whose work explores LGBT and queer identity. Keylock has presented at On the Boards, DanceSource Houston, Ten Tiny Dances, and New Expressive Works.

**Sotaé** is a rising hip-hop/R&B artist who is winning crowds for her collaborations with other Portland artists like Fountaine and Veana Baby.



Spirit Heart features Sherrie Davis's (Navajo/Saskatchewan Cree / Indigenous Mexican) and Wendy Young's (Cherokee) blend of acoustic guitar and Native American flute. The duo won the 2020 Global Music Silver Outstanding Achievement Award for the album *The Journey Home*.



**Tango Berretin** trio has been performing for tango dancing audiences across the US for over a decade. The band features **Andrew Oliver** on piano, **Alex Krebs** on bandoneon and **Megan Yvonne** on vocals.



**Tashon Phoenix** is a Black Queer Non-Binary Transmasc creative and spoken-word artist born in Tucson, Arizona, now living in Portland.



**Teeth** is a BIPOC alt-hard rock band from Portland Oregon looking to express themselves creatively and trying to make the world a better place.



**Tiel Aisha Ansari** is a writer whose books include *Knocking from Inside*, *High-Voltage Lines*, *Country Well-Known as an Old Nightmare's Stable*, *The Day of My First Driving Lesson*, and *Dervish Lions*. She hosts *Wider Window Poetry* on KBOO.


